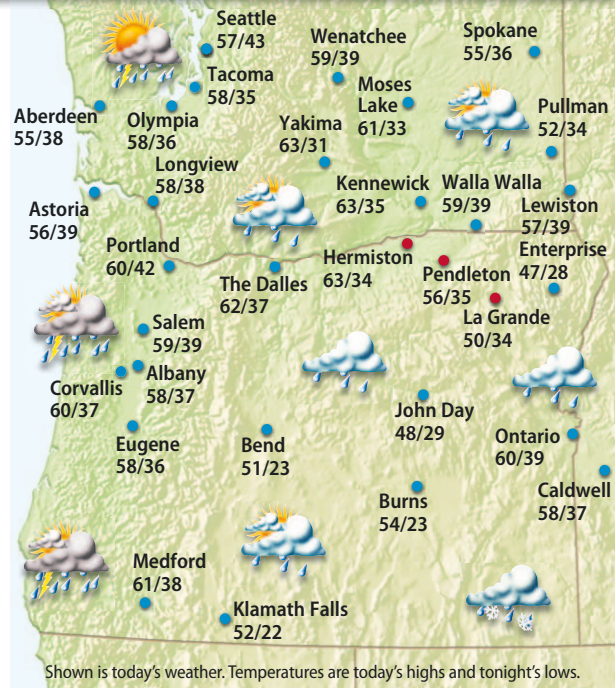

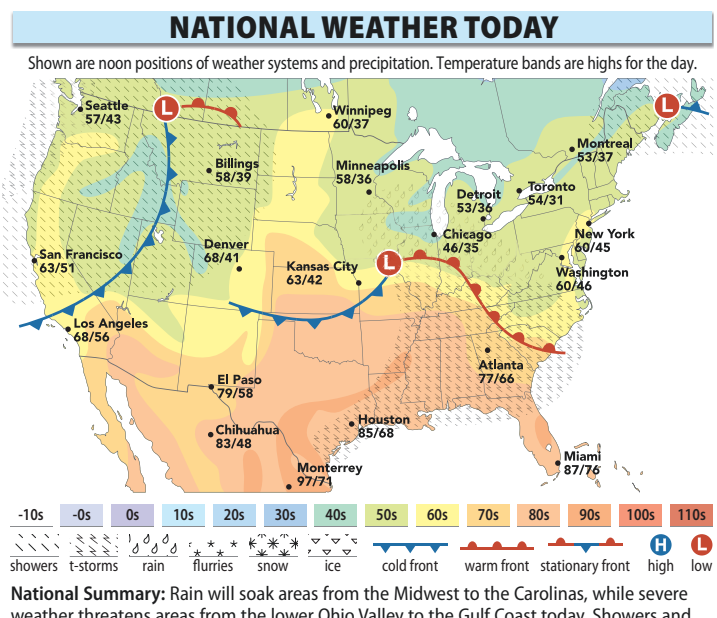
REGIONAL FORECAST
