SALEM (AP) — Oregon senators have passed legislation requiring a state agency to maintain a list of chemicals that are potentially harmful in children's toys and products.

Over the past six months, Jackson County Building Services has received 17 complaints about marijuana growers violating land-use laws. Director Kelly Madding said. Trees along a creek were cut down, and a vernal pool, habitat for a protected species of freshwater shrimp, was bulldozed. Four citations were issued.

The measure is similar to a bill senators shelved two years ago after it passed the House. The bill would have set up a database to track the use of 19 chemicals shown to be harmful to children and phased them out after five years.
