Shown are noon positions of weather systems and precipitation. Temperature bands are highs for the day.

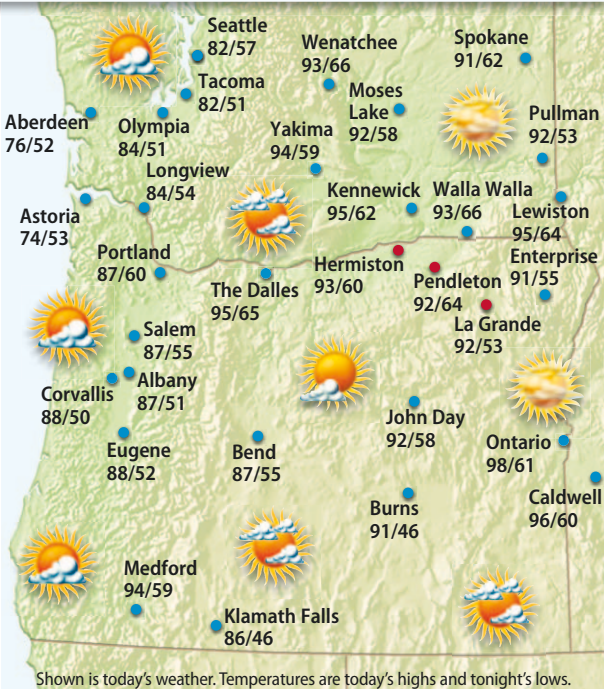
Legend:

Ranch managers Buck and Chelsea Matthews were scrambling to round up cattle and haul them to safety as the Grizzly Bear Complex turned for Eden Bench Monday morning.

"Buck hasn't had three hours sleep in three days," said Chelsea

But landlines still do. The Matthews contacted Wallowa County commissioners in Enterprise to intercede on their behalf Monday morning and Commissioner Paul Castilleja headed for their ranch as Commissioner Mike Hayward headed for the Incident Manage-

"That's really dangerous country and Buck is not willing to put anyone else in danger," Chelsea Matthews said. "They're going to stay safe and do the best they can. They've got radios and are in touch

with the Forest Service.”

All of the other stock on the 10,000-acre ranch are accounted for, Chelsea Matthews said.

“All the home ranch cows are all right,” she said. “We lost tons of pasture and timber, probably around 6,000 acres, but what our friends and (fellow) ranchers did was outstanding. They hauled 20 head

The structures on the ranch were all preserved, Matthews said.

About 116 personnel from multiple agencies, including the U.S. Forest Service, the Oregon Department of Forestry and the Joseph City Fire Department, are on the ground fighting the fire. Four engines and two water tankers are in service on the blaze, while several helicopters are being shared with the Grizzly Bear Complex Fire near Troy. Wallowa County Emergency Services and the Wallowa County Sheriff's Office are assisting with closing off Hurricane Creek Road and serving evacuation notices.



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
