

NATIONAL WEATHER TODAY

Shown are noon positions of weather systems and precipitation. Temperature bands are highs for the day.

The map displays the following weather features:

- High Pressure Systems (H):** Located over the central US (near Kansas City) and the Great Lakes (near Minneapolis).
- Low Pressure Systems (L):** Located off the West Coast (near Seattle), in the Northeast (near New York), and off the East Coast (near Miami).
- Weather Fronts:**
 - Cold Fronts (blue line with triangles):** One runs from the Great Lakes southward through the Ohio Valley and into the Gulf of Mexico. Another runs from the Northeast low pressure system southward along the Atlantic coast.
 - Warm Fronts (red line with semicircles):** One runs from the West Coast low pressure system northeastward through the Pacific Northwest and into the Great Lakes. Another runs from the Northeast low pressure system northeastward into the Atlantic.
 - Stationary Fronts (blue line with alternating triangles and semicircles):** One runs from the West Coast low pressure system southward along the California coast.

 - rain:** Indicated by vertical lines in the Pacific Northwest and the Gulf of Mexico.
 - flurries:** Indicated by horizontal lines in the Great Lakes region.
 - snow:** Indicated by snowflake symbols in the northern Great Lakes region.
 - ice:** Indicated by horizontal lines with dots in the northern Great Lakes region.

Legend:

- Temperature Bands:** -10s, -0s, 0s, 10s, 20s, 30s, 40s, 50s, 60s, 70s, 80s, 90s, 100s, 110s.
- Precipitation Symbols:** showers, t-storms, rain, flurries, snow, ice.
- Front Symbols:** cold front, warm front, stationary front.
- Pressure Symbols:** high, low.
