Shown are noon positions of weather systems and precipitation. Temperature bands are highs for the day.

This map displays the current weather across the United States. Temperature bands, representing the high for the day, are shown in 10-degree Fahrenheit increments from -10°F to 110°F. Precipitation is indicated by various symbols: solid lines for rain, dashed lines for showers, and icons for snow (flurries, snow, or ice). Weather systems are marked with 'H' for high pressure and 'L' for low pressure. Key cities and their current temperatures/expected highs are labeled.
