was known as Osborn Floor Covering. He semi-retired his business and went to work for Connor’s Mr. Carpet. After his retirement, Tom continued doing floor covering until his death.

Tom enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping, going to yard sales, and four-wheeling in the mountains looking for deer and elk sheds. He also enjoyed working in his shop rebuilding Jeeps and tinkering around. His place was being in his shop drinking a beer and watching TV. later she worked as a secretary to the Milton city manager and did billing for customers of power and water, posting payments and collections. Leona was a member of the First Christian Church where she served as a deaconess and was a member of the

Christian Endeavor Group. For 10 years she volunteered for the Red Cross, worked for many years on Election Day counting ballots and served as chairman for a few years. She was also a member of the Order of Eastern Star Loyalty Chapter #47 and the Art Club. She enjoyed ballroom and square dancing, Bridge, picnicking, camping and mushroom picking.
