**CW-73:** The Applicant proposes to conserve water by piping two miles and eliminating use of an add'l 1.5 miles of the Milton Ditch, moving the point of diversion 1.1 miles downstream, piping of a portion of the Powell Pleasantview Ditch, and installation of an automated headgate. The project is expected to yield approx. 2.18 CFS of conserved water from the Walla Walla River under Certificates 86912, 86915, 86917 thru 86919, 86922 thru 86931, 86941, 86947 thru 86948, 86967 thru 86968, and 86972 with priority dates of 1875 through 1905. It is proposed that 100% of the conserved water will be protected instream from the POD on the Walla Walla River to the Oregon-Washington state line.

**CW-74:** The applicant proposes to conserve water by piping the upper portion of the Powell Pleasantview Ditch and installation of a new automated headgate. The new headgate will significantly reduce the operation spill on the Powell Pleasantview Ditch. The project is expected to yield approx. 1.9 CFS of conserved water from the Walla Walla River under Certificates 86906 thru 86910, 86913, 86917 thru 86921, 86932, 86933, 86934, 86935 thru 86940, 86942 thru 86946, and 86971 with priority dates of 1880 thru 1908. It is proposed that 100% of the conserved water will be protected instream from the POD on the Walla Walla River to the Oregon-Washington state line.
