Balanced Sasquatch hold off Timberwolves

PENDLETON — Six players reached double-digit scoring and Spokane remained atop the NWAC East standings with a 95-83 win over Blue Mountain on Saturday.

The Sasquatch (17-2, 3-0 East) shot 65.9 percent (29 of 44) from inside the three-point arc and got 38 points off the bench to hold off the Timberwolves (9-9, 0-3).

The loss came with a season-high 26 points on 10-of-16 shooting from guard Rayfield Bell, who was coming off a previous season high of 16 against Big Bend the night before. He added eight rebounds, six assists and five steals against Spokane.

EASTERN OREGON 74, SOUTHERN OREGON 64 — At La Grande, Calvin Johanson scored 23 points on 9-of-11 shooting and Eastern made a big halftime lead stick to down the Raiders in Cascade Collegiate Conference play Saturday.

Travis Meeker added 15 points and Trell Washington chipped in seven points to go with a team-high 11 rebounds for Eastern (9-11, 5-5 CCC), which shot 43.1 percent (28-65) from the field for the game.

UTAH 59, OREGON STATE 53 — At Salt Lake City, Oregon State's Jarmal Reid tripped a referee and was ejected with 2:56 remaining, starting Utah's rally that led to a 59-53 victory Sunday night.

Reid was assessed a Flagrant 2 for the trip, and Brandon Taylor made the free throw to give Utah a 53-52 lead. The Beavers were outscored 6-1 the rest of the way.

COLORADO 91, OREGON 87 — At Boulder, Colo., Josh Scott scored 17 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, the bench added 45

points, and Colorado held on to beat Oregon on Sunday.

Dillon Brooks scored 21 points on 9-of-13 shooting with five assists for Oregon (14-4, 3-2). Tyler Dorsey made 4 of 8 3-pointers and finished with 19 points.

Women's Basketball SPOKANE 94, BLUE MOUNTAIN 79 — At Pendleton, the Blue Mountain Timberwolves couldn't keep up with the hot-shooting Spokane Sasquatch on Saturday night, leading to a 94-79 loss.

The Sasquatch (12-6, 1-2 East) shot 53 percent (35-66) from the floor and 50 percent (9-18) from 3-point range in the game while Blue Mountain (7-10, 1-2) did all they could in shooting 42 percent (28-66) from the floor and 50 percent (8-16) from 3-point range.

Bri King led Spokane with 25 points on 9-14 shooting and 4-7 from 3-point land. Savannah Heugly continues to pace the Timberwolves and did so again with 21 points and 11 rebounds.

EASTERN OREGON 75, SOUTHERN OREGON 69 — At La Grande, there are no more unbeaten teams in NAIA Division II women's basketball after Payton Parrish and Nikki Osborne combined for 42 points in a win over No. Southern Oregon on Saturday in Cascade Collegiate Conference play.

Parrish drilled six 3-pointers to finish with 22 points and Osborne shot 10-for-11 from the charity stripe, pulled down eight rebounds and added five assists to highlight her 20-point night.

OREGON 69, CALIFORNIA 59 — At Eugene, Jillian Alleyne scored 25 points and had 15 boards to become the Pac-12's all-time leading rebounder, and Oregon picked up its first

conference victory on Sunday.

Alleyne has 1,574 rebounds, surpassing former Stanford star Chiney Ogwumike, who had 1,567. The senior also posted her 83rd career double-double.

OREGON STATE 58, STANFORD 50 — At Corvallis, the Beavers snapped a 29-game losing streak to Stanford on Sunday.

Deven Hunter had 19 points with 12 rebounds and No. 12 Oregon State rallied to beat No. 11 Stanford. The last time Oregon State beat Stanford was in 2001, an 81-65 victory in Corvallis.

Track & Field

NAMPA, Idaho — The Eastern Oregon University indoor track & field team wrapped up its season opener at the Ed Jacoby Invitational on Saturday afternoon, and the Mountaineers brought home three automatic qualifiers for the NAIA Indoor Championships and a pair of record-breaking performances.

Newcomer Jebari Cumberbatch shined on day two of the event, as he

broke two school records for EOU. In the 60-meter dash, Cumberbatch earned second with a time of 6.93, and he later finished third in the 200 with a mark of 22.26.

In the women's 200, EOU saw a pair of top-10 finishes by both Megan Sullivan (25.87) and Andrea Lemus (26.03), of Umatilla, as they took sixth and eighth, respectively. Sullivan also notched a fourth-place finish and punched her ticket to nationals in the 400m with a time of 58.14.

Also for EOU, Amie Zitterkob of Umatilla and Amanda Fowler of Pendleton, who posted top-10 marks in EOU history in the 60 meters (8.10) and long jump (16-3.75 feet), respectively. Zitterkob and Lemus both ran for the third-place 1,600-meter relay, and Boardman's Jason Hendricks was fourth in the men's weight throw (47-1.5) and sixth in shot put (44-4.75).

Pendleton's Kevin Robinson finished fifth in the men's heptathlon with 4,369 points competing for Portland State.
