Cynthia Purvis

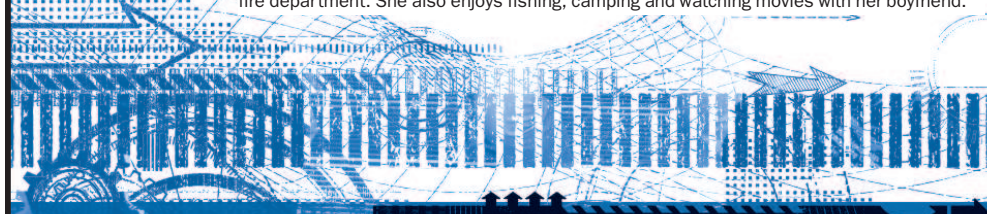
Meet Cynthia Purvis, Adjunct College Prep Instructor, BMCC Boardman.
