Local restaurant serves community support

Roosters Restaurant is stepping up to the plate to help with a budget shortfall at the Children's Museum of Eastern Oregon.

Through Thursday, March 3, the restaurant will donate \$1 to the museum for every kid's meal purchased. In addition, it will match any donations made at the eatery, up to \$500. The restaurant is located at 1515 Southgate, Pendleton.

The budget shortfall is the result of a change in funding priorities of three regular museum supporters, which resulted in a \$12,000 deficit for 2016. Like many small town children's museums, CMEO struggles each year to keep its doors open, said Heidi Anderson, museum director. While utilization of the museum has increased, admissions revenue doesn't provide enough for operating expenses.

Roosters is stepping up to the challenge and giving back to the community."

With more than 13,000 visitors annually and 150 memberships, many families, childcare providers and educa-

tors throughout the region enjoy and depend on the children's museum to provide a safe, fun and educational place to enjoy with their children, Anderson said. She is grateful for the support of Roosters and others in the community.

The Children's Museum of Eastern Oregon began in 1996 with a mission to provide children of all ages with opportunities for educational exploration and development through interactive exhibits and play. It was created through the collaborative efforts of more than 300 community volunteers. It is the only children's museum in Eastern Oregon, providing a unique resource to Pendleton and the surrounding communities.

Writer gives voice to daughters of pop culture

PENDLETON — An author whose work has been described as "richly narrative, deeply engaging, and warm" will be featured at this month's First Draft Writers' Series.

Brittney Corrigan was raised in Colorado and holds a degree from Reed College in Portland. She is the poetry editor for the online journal Hyperlexia: poetry and prose about the autism spectrum. In addition, her poems have appeared in numerous journals and anthologies.

Corrigan will read from her new work Thursday at 7 p.m. at Pendleton Center for the Arts, 214 N. Main St. The event also includes a short open mic for audience members. First Draft is free and open to the public.

In her poetry collection "Navigation," Corrigan enters the uncharted waters where she must establish the way not only for herself, but for her child with autism. Also, Corrigan describes "Daughters," the new manuscript she's working on, as a series of persona poems that re-imagine characters from mythology, folklore, fairy tales and pop culture from the perspective of their daughters.
