NOTICE OF DISTRICT MEASURE ELECTION

Notice is hereby given on February 18, 2016 that a measure election will be held in Echo School District 5R, located in Umatilla County, Oregon on May 17, 2016. The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters.

Caption: Authorizes General Obligation Bonds for Echo School District

Question: Shall the District issue \$4,000,000 bonds to provide instructional spaces, gymnasium, student safety, community center; obtain a \$4,000,000 State grant? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: If the bonds are approved, the State will provide a \$4,000,000 grant for the project. If not approved, these State funds will go to another District. In addition, the District will apply for additional grants to defray some of the costs of the projects. Passage of this measure will finance construction, renovation, equipping and furnishing school facilities including:

- Increase classroom spaces to address the 20% enrollment increase over the past five years.
- New regulation gymnasium for meeting state PE time requirements and hosting tournaments and activities. Echo is only school in our league with only one gym.
- Replace building and expand Career and Technical Education, integrating Science, Ag, Art, and CTE. Additional matching grant funds are available for these programs
- Address student safety recommendations
- Provide flexible community space for the Pioneer Senior Center and a community fitness room
- Upgrades to elementary restrooms
- Elementary Reading area

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 21 years from date of issuance and may be issued in one or more series.
