He enjoyed caring for his home and lawn. Until recently, Wayne remained active, riding his bicycle or walking nearly every day.

Wayne is survived by his wife of 65 years, Elizabeth

(Bettie) of Ukiah; four children, Arla (Paul Gammond) of Pendleton, Don (Judy) of Heppner, Clint (Norma) of Ukiah and Pamela (James Steinke) of Terrebonne; nine grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren; sister Ethel and brother Earl. He was preceded in death by his parents, sisters Opal and Clemma, and brother James.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, April 15, 2016, at 2:00 in the afternoon at the Ukiah School gymnasium in Ukiah, Oregon.
