The Selected Alternative is Alternative B with no modifications. The Selected Alternative includes approximately 1,270 acres of commercial vegetation treatments, approximately 1,276 acres of non-commercial vegetation treatments, commercial and noncommercial treatments in Riparian Habitat Conservation Areas. and approximately 942 acres of prescribed fire. Riparian planting, placement of large woody debris, and subsoiling are also included.
