# Mountaineers win first conference championship in softball

### Eastern Oregon beats Great Falls in extra inning

ASHLAND — Sophomore Maryssa Santi beat out a groundball to second base to allow the game-winning run to score with two outs in the bottom of the eighth inning as the Eastern Oregon University softball team claimed its first-ever Cascade Collegiate Conference championship 3-2 over Great Falls on Sunday.

Hailey Kline pitched the first five innings for the Mountaineers (29-21), but left with her team trailing 2-1 in the sixth inning.
