Introduction
The Oregon Department of Energy (department), staff to the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC or Council), received an Application for Site Certificate (application) from Wheatridge Wind Energy, LLC (applicant) for the construction and operation of the Wheatridge Wind Energy Facility (proposed facility), a wind generation facility with a nominal generating capacity of 500 megawatts. Under Oregon law, the applicant must obtain a site certificate from EFSC before constructing and operating the proposed facility. The department issued a Draft Proposed Order on the application on April 27, 2016. The Draft Proposed Order recommends EFSC approve the application and grant a Site Certificate, subject to the conditions listed in the order.

Description of the Proposed Facility
The proposed facility would consist of up to 292 wind turbines divided into two groups: Wheatridge West and Wheatridge East; and an interconnection corridor containing up to two parallel overhead 230-kilovolt (kV) transmission lines connecting Wheatridge West and Wheatridge East. In addition, the proposed facility includes the following related and supporting facilities:

- 34.5-kV collector lines and substations
- Meteorological tower
- Communication and SCADA System
- Operations and maintenance buildings
- Access roads
- Temporary construction areas
- Temporary concrete batch plants

Location of Proposed Facility
The Wheatridge Wind Energy Facility is proposed to be located on approximately 13,097 acres of privately owned land within Morrow and Umatilla counties.

Public Hearings and Comment Period
Public hearings on the Draft Proposed Order will be held on Thursday, May 19, 2016 and Monday, June 6, 2016 at Boardman City Hall in Boardman, Oregon. The public comment period on the Draft Proposed Order includes two public hearings, the first hearing beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 19, 2016 and the second hearing beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, June 6, 2016 (*it is not necessary for participants to attend both of the hearings*). Written comments are due no later than the close of the final public hearing. Written comments may be submitted prior to the public hearings by mail, email, hand-delivery or fax to the hearing officer, in care of:

Written or oral comments may be provided at the public hearings. The Council will not accept comments on the application or on the Draft Proposed Order after the close of the record at the conclusion of the final public hearing.

To be eligible to participate in a contested case on this application, a person must raise an issue either in person at one of the public hearings or in a written comment submitted after April 27, 2016 and received by the department before the record closes on June 6, 2016. Even if a person commented before April 27, 2016, that person must raise issues, either in person at one of the public hearings or in writing during the comment period, to be eligible to participate in the contested case.

For consideration in the contested case, issues raised must be within the Council's jurisdiction and must be raised with sufficient specificity so that the Council, the department, and the applicant understand the issue being raised and are afforded an opportunity to respond to the issue. To raise an issue with sufficient specificity, a person must present facts that support the person's position on the issue.

EFSC Decision Process
Following the final public hearing, the Council intends to review the Draft Proposed Order and public hearing comments at its regularly scheduled Council meeting on June 17, 2016. Following its review, either at that meeting or at a subsequent meeting, the Council will direct agency staff to prepare and issue a Proposed Order to approve or deny the application, and to issue a Notice of Contested Case. Following the contested case, the Council will issue a Final Order on the application.
