Fourth of July parade deadline coming soon

The Pendleton Fourth of July Parade will once again kick off at 10 a.m. on the morning of Monday, July 4 from the Pendleton Chamber of Commerce parking lot, 501 S. Main St.

The parade theme this year is "America: Yesterday & Today." The grand marshals are Joe Cole, a Korean War veteran, and Bob Michaels, a World War II veteran.

Entry forms can be picked up at the Pendleton Chamber of Commerce, Elite Guns & Bows, Dean's Athletic, Roundup Athletic Club or by emailing a request to fbradbury@yahoo.com. For those who would like their entries to be judged, the registration form needs to be turned into the Pendleton Chamber of Commerce no later than Monday, June 27. The parade will flow down Main Street, turn west on Court Avenue to the Round-Up Grounds and then turn east on Dorion Avenue to Southwest Fourth Street and back to the starting point.

The parade is hosted by the Pendleton VFW Let'er Buck Post 922. Before the parade starts, VFW members will pass out free small American flags along the parade route, as long as supplies last.

The judging and announcing stand will be located on Main Street adjacent to Hamley's Park. Parade trophies will be handed out at Hamley's Park at noon. All are invited to participate in the parade and the trophy presentation.

Motorcycle films highlight Hodaka Days

Award-winning filmmaker Peter Starr will present a personal screening of three flicks during this weekend's Hodaka Days.

The movies, which include "The Making of Bad Rock," which was shot in Weston, "The Making of Take it to the Limit" and "Bol Dor - 24 Hours of Lemans," will be shown free of charge Friday from 8-9:30 p.m. at the Long Branch Cafe in Weston.

Although it's been 52 years since Hodaka trail bikes and motorcycles were manufactured in Athena, hundreds of enthusiasts will make their way to Eastern Oregon for the June 23-26 celebration. Athena City Park serves as celebration central, but activities are held in Athena and Weston.

The fun kicks off Thursday from 2-4 p.m. with the Umatilla County TT and Poker Run. The 50-mile ride features back roads of Eastern Oregon. It starts at Suzie's Handi Mart in Weston. The registration fee is \$25 or \$20 for club members.

Food and beverage service is offered Thursday from 3-6 p.m. at Athena City Park. Also, an ice cream social and Gem Theater open house is from 6:30-9 p.m.

Friday activities include the Bad Rock Reunion Trail Ride from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. It departs from downtown Weston. The registration fee is \$25 or \$20 for club members. The Swap Meet and Hodaka Club Tent will be open from noon to 4:30 p.m. at the park in Athena.

Saturday offers a full day of fun, including a parade (11:15 a.m.), swap meet (9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.), bike show (noon to 2:30 p.m.), car show (10 a.m. to 3 p.m.) and silent auction (10 a.m. to 3 p.m.). The Observed Trials are from 8:30-11 a.m. at the Grain Elevator Trials Course. The entry fee is \$25 or \$20 for Hodaka Club members.

The banquet dinner is Saturday at 6:30 p.m., and the awards presentation, raffle and auction runs from 7:30-9 p.m. Both events are at Athena

Elementary School. Tickets must be purchased in advance for the barbecue chicken and ribs dinner, which cost \$12 each.

The event crescendos with Sunday's MX Racing from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Diamond Eye Track.

A special raffle to benefit Athena's Gem Theater restoration project will be drawn Saturday evening. Up for grabs is a 1976 NOS Model 03 Hodaka Wombat motor restored by George Cone, a Hodaka expert. Tickets are \$5 each and are available Friday and Saturday at the Hodaka Club Tent or the awards banquet. The winner doesn't have to be present.

Don't forget to pick up an Iron Man card and get it punched as you participate or volunteer in events to earn a Hodaka Club Iron Man patch. People must participate in at least five activities, including the poker run, trail ride, parade, health check-up, bike show, observed trial or motocross.
