Biles soars for gold, Raisman takes silver

United States continues dominance in individual women's all-around

RIO DE JANEIRO - Forget the pressure. Forget the hype.
Biles is immune to all of it.
Dynamic on vault. Effortless on beam. Jaw-dropping on floor. Brilliant all over. And now, finally, an Olympic champion.

The 19 -year-old American soared to the all-around title on Thursday putting the gap between herself and
the rest of the world on full display under the Olympic spotlight. Her total of 62.198 was well clear of silver medalist and "Final Five" teammate Aly Raisman and Russian bronze
medalist Aliya Mustafina.

for the Colorado Avalanche.
