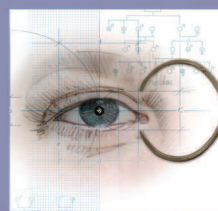


Legend & Legacy: Jackson Sundown and Happy Canyon A Century Later September 2 - October 29
