### ENAMEL JEWELRY: PAINTING WITH FIRE LINDA KUCERA, INSTRUCTOR

Learn the immersion process of enameling, patented by Barbara Lewis, author of the top rated book, "Torch-Fired Enamel Jewelry, a Workshop in Painting With Fire". This process uses a torch instead of a kiln to paint metal beads with colored glass, eliminating the time, expense and clean-up that traditionally go along with kiln enameling. Learn about metals as well as opaque and transparent enamels as you create one of a kind beads. Linda will teach basic safety measures to get students comfortable with the torch too. All tools and supplies are provided. Please wear closed-toe shoes and glasses or safety glasses- the PCA has a stash available for students to use.
