The opening exhibition of the 2016-17 season at the Betty Feves Memorial Gallery features the work of Katie Steinberg. An emerging artist from Portland, Steinberg recently completed a master of fine arts degree from the Tyler School of Art at Temple University in Philadelphia. “Asunder: a reconstruction of space and place” opens Thursday with a reception from 4:30-6:30 p.m. in the gallery, which is located in Pioneer Hall at Blue Mountain Community College, 2411 N.W. Carden Ave., Pendleton. It is free and open to the public. Steinberg creates small architectural structures that reference familiar environments while creating

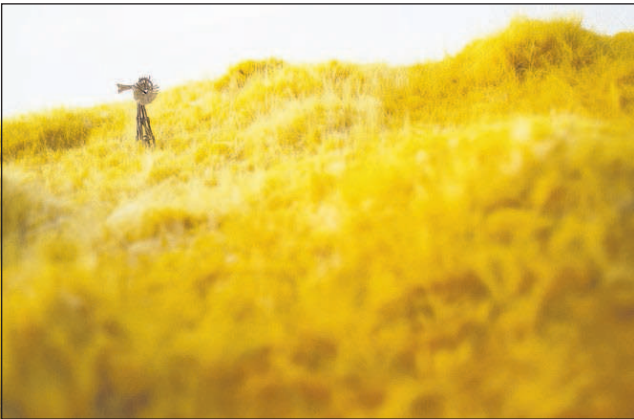

entirely new and fictional worlds. She works at a scale and with materials similar to architectural models and miniaturists. Her work explores the contemporary relationship between humans and technology and the natural world, looking at, for example, how our increasing use of and dependency on technology isolates us from our neighbors. “I’m interested in creating fictional envi-

ronments that question self-understanding and the impact of acting on the material world,” Steinberg said. Steinberg’s show includes sculptures as well as digital photography of these fictional worlds. The exhibit runs through Thursday, Oct. 27. The gallery is open Monday through Thursdays from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and by appointment by calling 541-278-5952.
