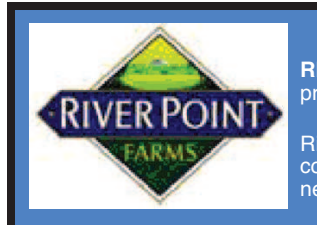

The Oregon Department of Agriculture ((ODA) has received an Application to Register (ATR) to the Oregon Confined Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) Individual National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. The application is for a new large federally defined CAFO dairy operation, Lost Valley Ranch, owned and operated by Greg te Velde; mailing address: PO Box 1210, Boardman, Oregon 97818, Phone (509) 201-0560. The proposed CAFO facility will be located on Homestead Lane 1.5 miles east of the intersection of Homestead Lane and Poleline Rd. in Hermiston, Oregon 97838 in Morrow County.

The proposed Permit was noticed on June 28, 2016 and the department held a public hearing in Boardman, Oregon on July 28, 2016. The comment period closed on August 4, 2016.
