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Prison officials are monitoring the health of a 26-year-old inmate who claims he stopped eating Nov. 1 to protest the treatment of inmates, their families and friends. Monte Gillespie, serving a 10-year prison term for first-degree manslaughter, has told officials at Eastern Oregon Correctional Institution he will not eat until Governor Barbara Roberts acknowledges the need to reappoint a corrections ombudsman, whose position in the governor's office was cut this year. In his letter, Gillespie said the ombudsman is needed "so that both the inmate and those that we know outside these walls can have a place to voice our complaints and concerns without fear of the state sweeping it under the rug."
