The Stanfield City Council will hold a public hearing regarding a proposal to amend the Stanfield Development Code and Transportation System Plan. The change would affect properties within the City's Downtown District. The following statement is required by state law; the City of Stanfield and Umatilla County have not made a determination regarding how these amendments would affect the value of your property: "Adoption of these amendments may affect the permissible uses of your property, and other properties in the affected zone, and may change the value of your property."

The amendment being considered and detailing the potential zoning map changes are available for inspection at Stanfield City Hall located at 160 South Main Street, Stanfield, OR 97875. Copies of the proposed amendments are available for purchase at a cost of \$0.10 per page.

Any interested person may submit written testimony prior to or at the public hearing. Comments may be sent to Stanfield City Hall. Comments received by December 1, 2016 will be included in the City Council packets sent to the City Councilors in advance of the December 6th meeting.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that permits testimony from those interested. The City Council will either adopt the amendments, or reject the proposed changes.
