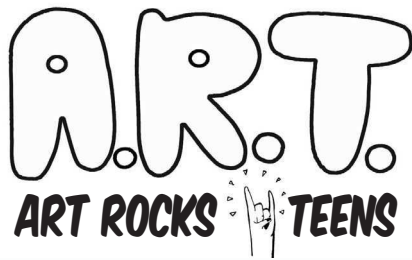


Free Teen Classes

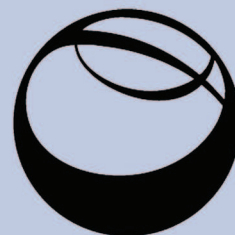
