Pendleton man shoots himself, lives

No one in Pendleton’s Fix-It Shop on December 23, 1907, was quite sure why George Bowles would point a pistol at his forehead and pull the trigger in the middle of the store, but fortunately for everyone involved, Bowles survived the attempt to end his own life.

Witnesses in the shop, located near the Lyman Meat Market on Court Street, stated that Bowles came into the establishment several times that day before noon to look at guns. The first time he requested to borrow a large-caliber pistol, saying he wanted to shoot rats. He returned about noon to look at pistols in a display case. “I wonder what Sorenson will take for this one,” Bowles commented, taking a .32-caliber pistol from the display case. Soon afterward he was seen repeatedly snapping the gun, stooping down behind the counter each time. Others in the shop had no way of knowing that Bowles was loading the gun with long .22-caliber cartridges.

Bowles then pointed the

pistol at his forehead and pulled the trigger, the ball lodging just under the skin. When the men in the shop rushed to pick him up, he was reported to have asked, “What have I done?” While Dr. J.A. Best was removing the ball, Bowles seemed confused as to what had happened. Afterward, the wounded man was able to walk to the home he shared with his mother on West Court Street.

Though Bowles was familiar to the employees of the Fix-It Shop, having visited the shop on many occasions, not much was known about him besides his suffering from rheumatism. He moved to Pendleton in 1905 and had just returned from Spokane, where he had been working, two weeks prior to the shooting incident. He also was reported to have had a considerable drinking habit, which many said contributed to Bowles’ rash action.

100 Years Ago

Dec. 10-11, 1916

Burglary of the home of Hugh Bell and the theft of a pair of heavy overshoes led to the capture early this morning of Harvey Bensene, one the four men who escaped from the county jail Thursday afternoon. Bell, whose farm is near Helix, left home with his family about 3 o’clock yesterday afternoon. Bensene, who had been hiding in an empty house on the Dr. C.J. Smith place across the road, saw him leave and at once entered the house. He took food, some coins belonging to the children and a pair of Mr. Bell’s overshoes among other things. Sheriff Taylor and Deputy Estes, together with Mr. Bell, tracked the man through the snow during the night and about 4 o’clock this morning found him sleeping peacefully at the farmhouse of E.C. Snapp a mile and a half this side of Helix.

50 Years Ago

25 Years Ago

Each Christmas, Lou Jirovec remembers the patients and staff at the cancer ward that treated her son with more than a simple greeting card. She and hundreds of staff and students at four Hermiston grade schools send paper Christmas trees to the UCLA Medical Center in Los Angeles. Known as the “Hands of Love,” the trees are made by students who draw outlines of their hands onto colored paper. The outlines are cut out and used to make “boughs” for the paper trees. Then the children go as wild as they wish, decorating the tree with photos, drawings, ornaments and glitter. Jirovec teaches second grade at Sunset Elementary School. In 1986, her adult son, Bob Robbins, was diagnosed with leukemia and treated at UCLA. He fought the disease for two years, enduring nine months of chemotherapy and a bone marrow transplant, before dying in the spring of 1988.

\$1,000 reward for catching ugly fish from Wyoming reservoir

GREEN RIVER, Wyo. (AP) — A \$1,000 reward has been posted for catching an ugly fish out of Fontenelle Reservoir in western Wyoming.

The fish are called burbot (BUR’-but) and they’re not native to the upper Green River drainage. Burbot compete with native game species including trout.

Burbot are eel-like but said to be good eating despite their appearance.

Getting more people to fish for burbot is one way

to reduce their numbers, so Game and Fish and Trout Unlimited are sponsoring a burbot raffle. Game and Fish has caught 25 burbot and tagged them with raffle tags.

The Rock Springs Rocket-Miner reports anybody who catches a tagged burbot from Fontenelle may enter a raffle with a \$1,000 grand prize.

The drawing will take place at a burbot fishing rally at Fontenelle Jan. 7-8.
