Grand jury indicts Glidewell for attempted murder, 16 other counts

assault. According to court records, the sex crime charges also constitute domestic violence.

John Paul Glidewell of Pendleton now faces 17 counts for assaulting a woman, including attempted murder and attempted rape.

The charges stem from the seven-page indictment a Umatilla County grand jury handed up Thursday after hearing testimony from the victim and sheriff's deputy Rachel Faber. The district attorney's office Friday morning arraigned Glidewell in circuit court in Pendleton on the following 10 felonies:

- three counts of first-degree kidnapping;
- unlawful sexual penetration;
- attempted first-degree rape;
- attempted murder;
- three counts of coercion;
- and unlawful use of a weapon.

Defense attorney Tom Gray entered not guilty pleas to all charges on behalf of Glidewell.

Jacklyn Jenkins, the chief deputy prosecutor for the district attorney, told the court that Glidewell's initial bail was \$500,000 when there were only four charges. Circuit Judge Christopher Brauer raised the bail to an even \$1 million.

Brauer also said he would set a release hearing once the defense submits a request.

The sheriff's office arrested Glidewell last Friday near Weston. He has been in the county jail, Pendleton, since.
