

OUT OF THE VAULT Woman reunited with long-lost son

When Evelyn May's family broke up in 1946 in Yakima, Wash., she wasn't sure she'd ever see her 3-year-old son Tommy Anthony DeRosa again. In 1982, after a series of phone calls and with the help of state police agencies on opposite coasts, May was reunited with Tommy when he traveled from his home in New York to Hermiston to meet her, as well as five siblings and their families.

May's other children, including sons Walt and John Blankenship and daughters Mary Kligel, Carol Longhorn and Janet Bailey, knew they had another brother, but weren't sure where he was. May thought Tommy's father might have taken him to New York after the couple split up. "We used to watch American Bandstand on television, and Mom would say, 'Watch for your brother.' She had some baby pictures, that was all," said Kligel.

Walt Blankenship took the initiative and began a search for Tommy. He spent \$104 on phone calls and learned that there were 15 Anthony DeRosas listed in New York phone directories. When he asked an officer with the Oregon State Police in Hermiston for advice, it was suggested he contact the New York State Police.

Not only did state police in New York locate the correct Anthony DeRosa, they handed off a letter to him written by Walt. DeRosa immediately called Walt, asking, "What took you so long?" He said he had always hoped he had siblings, but didn't know how to find them, or if they even existed. He was told as a boy not to ask about his mother.

DeRosa next called his mother, by chance on her birthday, and told her that not only had she found her long-lost son, but also a daughter-in-law, Lynn, and four grandchildren.

DeRosa flew into the Tri-Cities Airport on Jan. 17, 1982, and was immediately swept into the arms of a family he hadn't even dreamed of just a month before. He spent two weeks getting acquainted with his mother and a few dozen family members before returning to Queens, N.Y., where he worked as a truck driver and supervisor at a dairy. DeRosa planned to bring his family for another visit the following summer.

100 Years Ago From the East Oregonian Jan. 28-29, 1917

Bearing out the facetious suggestion made at the council last week that trains crossing East Court street are in more danger from speeding autos than autos are from the trains was an incident which happened early yesterday morning when Alex Breeding drove his car headon into a passing O.W. train. The auto, however, got the worst of the encounter, its whole front end being torn off. Breeding was unhurt.

50 Years Ago From the East Oregonian Jan. 28-29, 1967

Ka-whump! went the 12-ton steel plate as it pancaked a car body from five feet to four inches tall. Looking like an overgrown waffle iron, a Hermiston man's invention was busy this week smashing old car bodies at the new Lindell Auto Wrecking Yards. Lindell, whose yards are in the path of Interstate 80-N, is moving to a yard at the mouth of Wildhorse Creek in east Pendleton. Walt Thompson of Hermiston has invested close to \$50,000 in his car-smashing

business. His aim is to clean the countryside of old car bodies. Thompson and his crew are smashing over 400 cars in the Lindell yard.

25 Years Ago From the East Oregonian Jan. 28-29, 1992

David L. Selders was arraigned Monday on new and more serious charges related to the murder of a Brownsville couple on Weston Mountain in June of 1990. The Milton-Freewater man faces six counts of aggravated murder, which carry a potential death sentence, as a result of a guilty plea entered by his co-defendant, Jon Q. Johnston, last week. Both men were originally charged with aggravated murder, but charges against Selders were reduced to intentional murder, which carry a possible sentence of life in prison, when Selders agreed in August of 1990 to testify against Johnston. But authorities determined that Selders left out self-incriminating information in his accounts of the crime. Instead of Selders testifying against Johnston, Johnston may testify against Selders.

Thief drives tractor through wall, steals safe

BERLIN (AP) — Police in northwestern Germany are searching for a brazen thief — or thieves — who knocked down the wall of a house with a tractor and made off with a safe.

Police say the tractor was used early Thursday morning to bash down the wall of the home in the town of Buende, west of Hannover, according to the dpa news agency.

The thief or thieves grabbed the safe and fled, and the John Deere farm tractor was left halfway inside the house.

Authorities say the home's residents weren't harmed in the robbery but refused to say what was being kept in the safe or to give any further information because of the ongoing investigation.

Woman nearly carjacked after stopping for dummy

NEWPORT, N.C. (AP) — A sheriff's office says a woman narrowly escaped being carjacked after spotting what she thought was a child sitting in the middle of the road in the dark of night.

It turned out to be a dummy, dressed in children's clothing. And as the woman slowed her car, two men wearing dark hoodies approached and pulled on her door handles.

She sped away and called for help as the suspects fled, according to the sheriff's office in Carteret County, North Carolina.

Maj. Jason Wank says authorities destroyed the dummy later Sunday, just in case. He's asking for help finding those responsible.
