## Round-Up Indian director dies in hunting accident

Robert Chauncey Bishop, known in Pendleton as Chauncey, who served during the 1920s as the Pendleton Round-Up's Indian director, was killed in a freak hunting accident near Pendleton in January 1927.

Chauncey was part of the Pendleton Woolen Mills legacy, and managed the Pendleton mill, which he and brothers Roy and Clarence bought in 1909. Other mills in Salem and Washougal, Wash., were managed by the Bishop brothers' parents, C.P. and Fannie Bishop.

On the afternoon of Saturday, Jan. 15, 1927, Bishop was hunting ducks near McKay Dam with two friends, Glen Stater and Sol Baum. The trio was wrapping up their hunting activities, and Stater was standing near the car talking to Baum, who was sitting inside. Stater said Bishop disappeared into a gully on his way to the car, so neither man witnessed the accident.

Both men heard a gun shot but weren't immediately concerned, thinking Bishop was shooting at ducks. When he didn't appear after a few minutes, the men hurried to the gully and found Bishop lying in shallow water at the bottom, head downward. The shotgun was a short distance away, the recoil having thrown it from Bishop's

hands. Bishop reported he had slipped on a rock and the gun went off accidentally, hitting him in the abdomen. It was a new gun, Stater and Baum said, and Bishop admitted he did not have the safety on when he slipped. He wasn't bleeding badly, and was able to help his friends get him to the car.

The men drove Bishop to St. Anthony Hospital in Pendleton, where he was immediately taken into surgery. He survived the surgery and was able to talk to his family, some of whom had traveled from Salem and Portland when news of his accident was received.

But later his condition started to deteriorate, and he was given a blood transfusion, donated by his brother Clarence, at 10 a.m. the next morning. Bishop briefly rallied, but died at 11:15 a.m. Sunday.

In addition to his brothers and his parents, Bishop left behind two sons, Robert, 17, and Charles, 13. His wife had died in 1918 during the Spanish Influenza epidemic, and Chauncey was laid to rest next to her in Salem.

## DAYS GONE BY

### 100 Years Ago From the East Oregonian March 11-12, 1917

Discovered immediately after they had blown the safe in the Brownell grocery at 3 o'clock this morning in Umatilla, two yeggmen were pursued down the track in a switch engine, overtaken and captured. Ex-Mayor E.E. Starcher and Art Spinning were responsible for the capture of the safecrackers. They were working on Starcher's car in a garage just opposite the grocery when they heard the explosion that opened the safe. They investigated and saw the men at work. They hastened to secure Earl Brownell, the proprietor, and the O.-W. yard officer. As they returned the two yeggmen were leaving the grocery and were fleeing up the track. Securing the switch engine, the four men started in pursuit and soon overtook them. While Starcher stayed with the engine, the other three jumped down and threw their guns on the robbers who submitted to capture without assistance. Some dynamite and glycerine were found on them as was also a small amount of money secured from the safe.

### 50 Years Ago From the East Oregonian March 11-12, 1967

The U.S. Forest Service has backed off, temporarily, on a new, controversial clause in its special-use permits,

which users of water originating on national forest lands see as a threat to their water supply. The new clause will not be a factor in renewals of the forest use permit until further clarification from the chief of the forest service. The trouble over the clause seems to stem from fear the government has spelled out in more specific language that it could take the water now used by ranchers and use it to irrigate timber land. The controversy started in January on the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest when a rancher started to renew his permit and found the new clause.

### 25 Years Ago From the East Oregonian March 11-12, 1992

A Portland man died Monday when a fire flashed through his pickup while he was traveling eastbound on Interstate 84 about one mile east of Patterson Ferry Road. Tung Thomas Trimm, 41, was dead at the scene Monday morning. The police investigation determined vapors from a gasoline-saturated blanket in a 5-gallon plastic container on the floor of Trimm's cab were suddenly detonated when he lit a cigarette, Morrow County Sheriff Roy Drago said. Witnesses in another car watched as the passenger compartment exploded, Drago said. The truck veered off the freeway and into a barbed wire fence.


