- The public must be able to verify that the notice was not altered once published.

Public notices in newspapers protect the right of due process as guaranteed to Americans by the Constitution.

1. Blue Mountain Community College (the "College") invites sealed bids for Campus Data Room Relocation and Fiber Optic Distribution Upgrade located on the Pendleton Campus. The project to be completed as detailed in the Contract Documents, together with and supporting items of work, all as required by, specified in, and shown on the Contract Documents. The Project will be executed with a design-bid-built delivery method.

a. The base bid(s) consist of:

- Installation of Fiber Optic Distribution system to existing and new wire closets utilizing existing and some new underground duct system.
- Providing power and fiber services to two modular building located on the west side of the Science & Tech building.
- Tenant improvement on the lower floor of Pioneer Hall.

b. The alternate bid(s) consist of:

- Construction of a new server room with backup generator.

Collectively referred to as the "Work" under this Contract and shall occur within the project boundary lines indicated on the Drawings. First-tier subcontractor forms will be due 2 hours later and only prime subcontractors will be allowed to perform work.
