



The city is anticipating abandoning the existing wastewater facility treatment lagoon and constructing a new evaporative wastewater facility on city-owned property west of the existing lagoons

Alternatives considered by RUS and the city of Pilot Rock include: No action, action alternative (preferred alternative) and alternatives eliminated. The alternatives are discussed in the city of Pilot Rock Wastewater Treatment Facility Project Environmental Assessment (EA). The RUS has reviewed and approved the EA for the proposed project.
