Title to the lands herein described shall be subject to any existing easements for public roads and highways, for public utilities and for railroads and pipelines or any other rights of way of record.

The notice and the envelope in which it is mailed should be clearly labeled "Notice of Appeal." Your notice of appeal must list the names and addresses of the interested parties known to you and certify that you have sent them copies of the notice. You must also send a copy of your notice of appeal to the Regional Director at: Bureau of Indian Affairs, Northwest Regional Office, 911 N. E. 11th Avenue, Portland, OR 97232. If you are an Indian or Indian Tribe and are not represented by an attorney, you may request assistance from this office in the preparation of your appeal.

You may include a statement of reasons with your notice of appeal, explaining why you believe the decision being appealed is in error. If you do not include your statement of reasons with your notice of appeal, you must mail or deliver it to the Superintendent's office within 30 days after you file your notice of appeal. The statement of reasons and the envelope in which it is mailed should be clearly labeled "Statement of Reasons." It must be accompanied by or otherwise incorporate all supporting documents. You must send copies of your statement of reasons to all interested parties and the Regional Director.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TEXT AMENDMENT, #T-17-074, COLUMBIA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, APPLICANT, WESTLAND IRRIGATION DISTRICT, OWNER. The applicant requests an amendment of the Comprehensive Plan Text and approval of an exception to Statewide Planning Goal 11 (Public Facilities and Services). The exception would allow for a sewer line extension from the City of Hermiston to the Umatilla Army Depot (Depot). The proposed sewer line would run west from the City of Hermiston within the public right of way of Bridge Road, then west across private lands owned by Westland Irrigation District, before reaching the Depot. The criteria of approval are found in Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 660, Divisions 4 and 11 and the Umatilla County Development Code Sections 152.750 through 152.755.

A copy of the staff report will be available for inspection or duplicated at least seven days before the hearing. Hearings shall be governed by Section 152.772 of the Umatilla County Development Code.
