DJEMBE RHYTHM WORKSHOP

Learn the tones and techniques of the Djembe, an African goblet-shaped drum that you play with your hands. We'll do exercises in basic rhythms, practice reading rhythm grid notation (a simple way to write down beats), and move up to African drumming arrangements. No music experience is necessary- this class is about discovering the fun of playing rhythm together! Students will be challenged to their individual skill level, and teens 13-18 years old are welcome to join for free!
