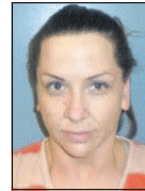

MILTON-FREEWATER

Two drive-by shooting suspects plead not guilty

Two suspects in the May 10 drive-by shooting in Milton-Freewater pleaded not guilty Thursday to attempted murder and more.

Francisco Javier Palacios-Garcia, 23, of Milton-Freewater, and Clemente Garcia-Cerda, 21, of Walla Walla, arrived Wednesday to the Umatilla County Jail, Pendleton. The pair were awaiting extradition from jail in Washington, where they have been since police arrested them in Walla Walla in the wake of the gang shooting, according to Milton-Freewater Police Chief Doug Boedigheimer.

A Umatilla County grand jury on May 24 indicted the pair on one count of attempted murder, two counts of unlawful

use of a weapon, and eight counts of reckless endangering. Garcia-Cerda also faces one count of felon in possession of firearm.

The Umatilla County Attorney's office arraigned them Thursday in Pendleton.

Boedigheimer reported in a previous statement Palacios-Garcia and Garcia-Cerda, around midnight May 10, drove by 905 N. Main St., Milton-Freewater, the home of Eric Rodriguez, 21, and shot at him. Rodriguez was unscathed, and the bullets penetrated the home, where several adults and children were at the time.

Palacios-Garcia and Garcia-Cerda remain in the Pendleton jail in lieu of \$1 million bail. Court records show Palacios-Garcia's next hearing is June 30, and Garcia-Cerda's is June 30.
