Tammy Burnett will share her glass-on-glass technique for laying mosaic onto a framed glass sheet, adhering with a silicone adhesive and grouting to finish off the piece. Most supplies will be provided including stained glass, glass objects, picture frames, glue, safety glasses and rubber coated gloves. Students supply your own glass nippers; Tammy will have them available for \$15 on the first night of class.
