She is survived by her son Wyatt Alford, Ukiah, Ore.; father Dennis Schneider, Umatilla, Ore.; sister Amy

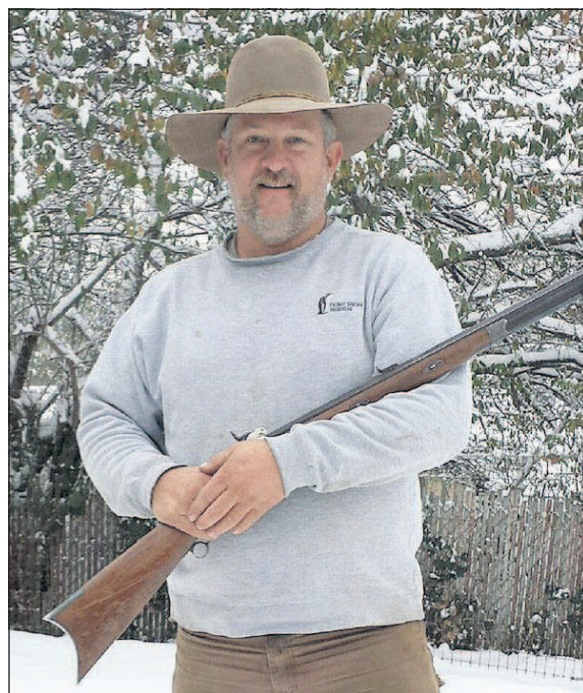
