'A Talk with Teddy' features Roosevelt re-enactor

Local audiences will be treated to a top-notch performance by Joe Wiegand — a premiere Theodore Roosevelt impersonator.

An actor and historian, Wiegand is featured during Heritage Dinner 2017: "A Talk with Teddy." The event, which benefits the Umatilla County Historical Society, is Tuesday, Oct. 10 at 5 p.m. at Heritage Station Museum, 108 S.W. Frazer Ave., Pendleton. Dinner will be served at 5:45 p.m. Tickets are \$50 for historical society members and \$55 for non-members.

According to his biography, Wiegand, who offers riveting performances as the 26th president of the United States, first started portraying Roosevelt in 2004. Rather than calling himself an impersonator or re-enactor, he refers to his role as a repriser.

In 2008, Wiegand and his family traveled across the United States in celebration of Theodore Roosevelt's 150th birthday. Performances at Roosevelt's New York City birthplace and the White

Performing and politics come naturally for Wiegand. His father was a stand-up Wiegand comedian and received a degree in political science at The University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee. He served in student government and was president of the American Legion Boys Nation program.

Before launching his career as a Roosevelt impersonator, Wiegand worked as a public policy professional, opinion survey expert and a political campaign consultant. His resume includes working on Mike Huckabee's 2008 presidential campaign in Illinois.
