This serves as public notice that the U.S. Army Chemical Materials Activity, Umatilla Chemical Depot (UMCD) submitted a Class 2 Permit Modification Request to modify the UMCD Hazardous Waste Permit (OR6 213 820 917). This Permit Modification Request [tracking number UMCD-17-001-CLOS(2)] was submitted to the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ).

**What is the permit modification request about?**
