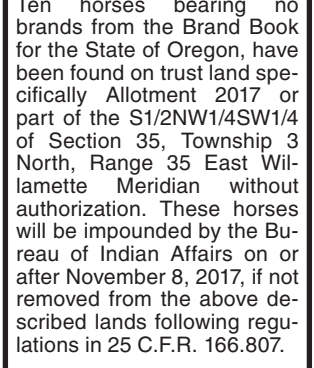

After the impoundment, own-
ers of unauthorized livestock
may redeem their livestock
by first submitting proof of
ownership and settling all of
the following obligations: (1)
a reasonable value of forage
consumed, (2) a penalty of
double the value of the forage
consumed, (3) damages to
Indian trust property injured
or destroyed and (4) all ex-
penses incurred in the inves-
tigation, impounding, feeding
and care of the livestock.
