Proposal: Boardman Solar Energy LLC, a subsidiary of Invenergy LLC, seeks a site certificate to construct and operate a solar photovol-
taic energy generation facility with a peak generating capacity of approximately 75 megawatts (MW) on 798 acres of private land.

Introduction
The Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE or Department), staff to the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC or Council), received an Ap-
plication for Site Certificate (ASC) from Boardman Solar Energy LLC (Applicant) to construct and operate the proposed Boardman Solar
Energy Facility (proposed facility). Under Oregon law, the Applicant must obtain a site certificate from EFSC before constructing and
operating the proposed facility. The Department issued a Draft Proposed Order on the ASC on November 13, 2017. The Draft Proposed
Order recommends EFSC approve the ASC and issue a Site Certificate, subject to the conditions listed in the order. The purpose of this
notice is to notify the public of the public hearing and open comment period extending through December 14, 2017.

Description of the Proposed Facility
The proposed facility would consist of an approximately 75-MW solar photovoltaic energy generation facility. In addition, the proposed
facility would include the following related and supporting facilities: underground electrical collection system, substation, control house
and generator step-up transformer, 115-kV transmission line (approximately 2.1 miles long) and private service road, point of intercon-
nection, operations and maintenance building, private access road, service roads, gates and security fence, and additional temporary
construction areas.

Location of Proposed Facility
The proposed facility would be located in Morrow and Gilliam counties, immediately south of Interstate 84 and approximately 12 miles
east of Arlington and 12 miles west of Boardman. The figure below represents the approximately 798-acre site boundary (see pink shaded
area). The solar energy generation components of the facility would be located entirely in Morrow County. The proposed 115-kV trans-
mission line, private service road and POI would be located entirely in Gilliam County.

Public Hearing and Comment Period
A public hearing on the Draft Proposed Order will be held at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, December 14, 2017 at Boardman City Hall. Written
comments are due no later than the close of the public hearing. Written comments may be submitted prior to the public hearing by mail,

Written or oral comments may also be provided at the public hearing. The Council will not accept comments on the ASC or on the Draft
Proposed Order after the close of the record at the conclusion of the public hearing.

To be eligible to participate in a contested case on this ASC, a person must raise an issue either in person at the public hearing or in a
written comment submitted on or after November 13, 2017 and received by the Department before the record closes on December 14,
2017. Even if a person commented before November 13, 2017, that person must raise issues, either in person at the public hearing or in
writing during the comment period, to be eligible to participate in the contested case.

For consideration in the contested case, issues raised must be within the Council's jurisdiction and must be raised with sufficient specifi-
city so that the Council, the Department, and the Applicant understand the issue being raised and are afforded an opportunity to respond
to the issue. To raise an issue with sufficient specificity, a person must present facts that support the person's position on the issue.

EFSC Decision Process
Following the public hearing, the Council will review the Draft Proposed Order and public hearing comments during its December 15,
2017 meeting. Following its review, either at that meeting or at a subsequent meeting, the Council will direct staff to prepare and issue a
Proposed Order, and issue a Notice of Contested Case. Following the contested case, the Council will issue a Final Order on the ASC. The
