QUESTION NUMBER TWO... WHAT IS THE LENGTH OF THE RIO GRANDE RIVER?

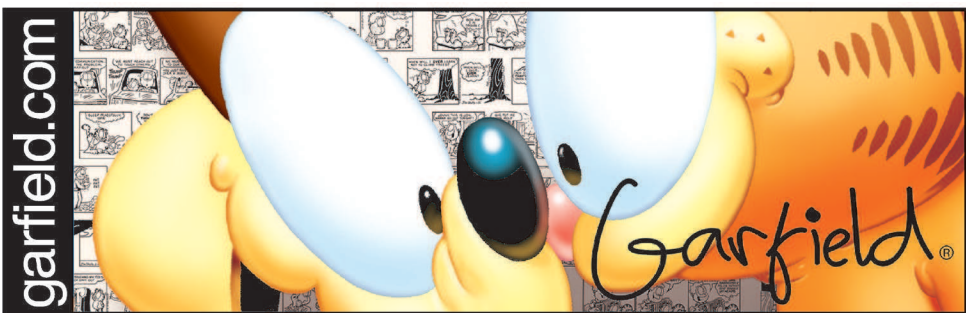
Answer: When I grow up, I will also probably be a housewife, and could not care less about the length of the Rio Grande river.

YEEOW!!!

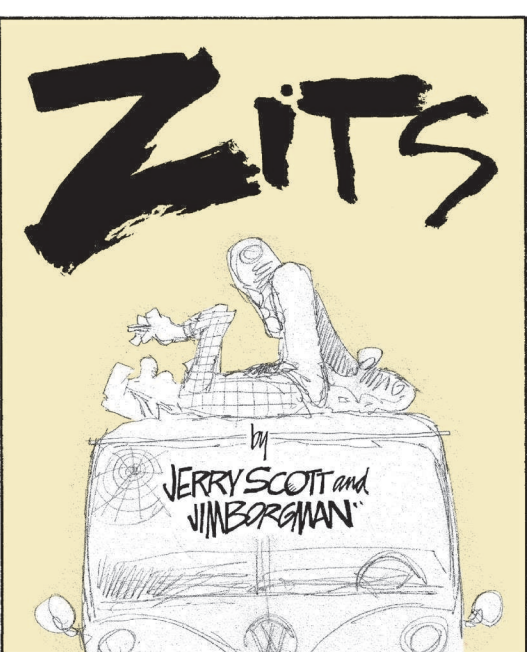
WHAT HAPPENED? DID I CLIP YOUR TOE?!
