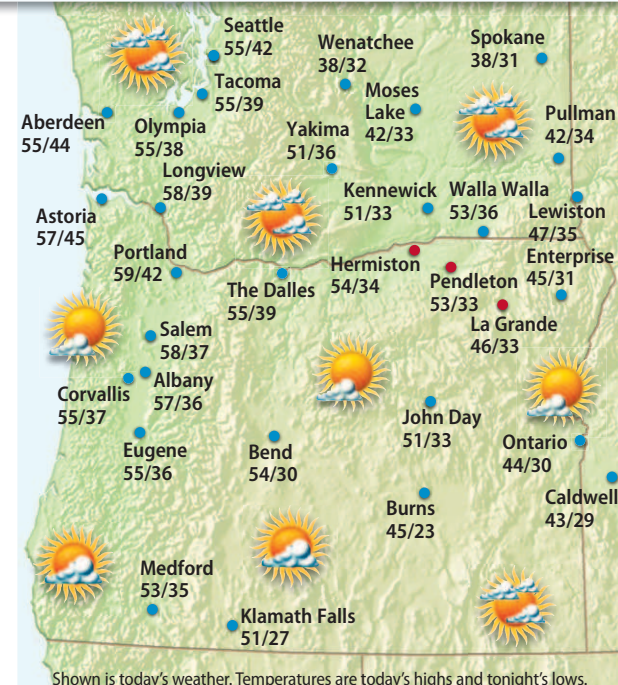

PENDELTON through 3 p.m. yesterday TEMPERATURE HIGH LOW. Includes precipitation and sun and moon data.



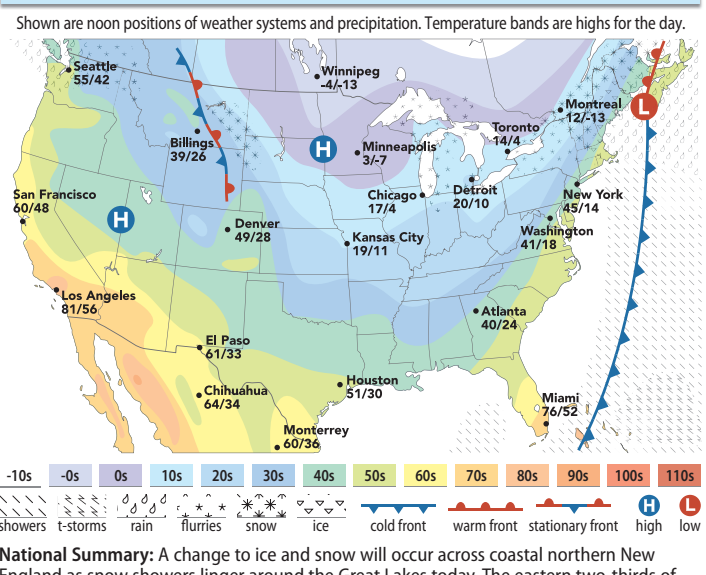

Governor office: Zinke to reconsider drilling off Oregon

SALEM (AP) — Interior Secretary Ryan Zinke agreed to consider exempting Oregon from the Trump administration's offshore drilling plan after speaking with Oregon Gov. Kate Brown, her office said Friday.
