Oregon went 13-17 during Graves' first season, averaging 1,501 in home attendance. During the 2015-16 campaign, the Ducks averaged 1,629 fans and made a run to the WNIT semifinals.

The real fun began last season when a programchanging recruiting class, led by all-Pac-12 selections Sabrina Ionescu and Ruthy Hebard, arrived on campus.

Oregon averaged 2,595 in attendance during the 2016-17 season at Matthew Knight Arena. Then the madness began with an upset of 11th-ranked Washington at the Pac-12 Tournament in Seattle, followed by a stunning run to the Elite Eight in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 10 seed.
