Hydromania Summer Science Camp, Umatilla Electric Cooperative. This camp focuses on science, water, our environment and energy through hands-on experiments and activities, field trips and interaction with other students. RecTennis Summer Camp, U.S. Tennis Association. Camp runs from 8 a.m. to noon, June 18 to Aug. 17 (no camp on July 4). This new version of summer tennis camp involves USTA-trained in-

structors, age-appropriate equipment and games to energize children from 6 to 14. Camp takes place at Armand Larive Middle School and focuses on tennis and movement as well as reading, arts and crafts. No previous experience is required.
