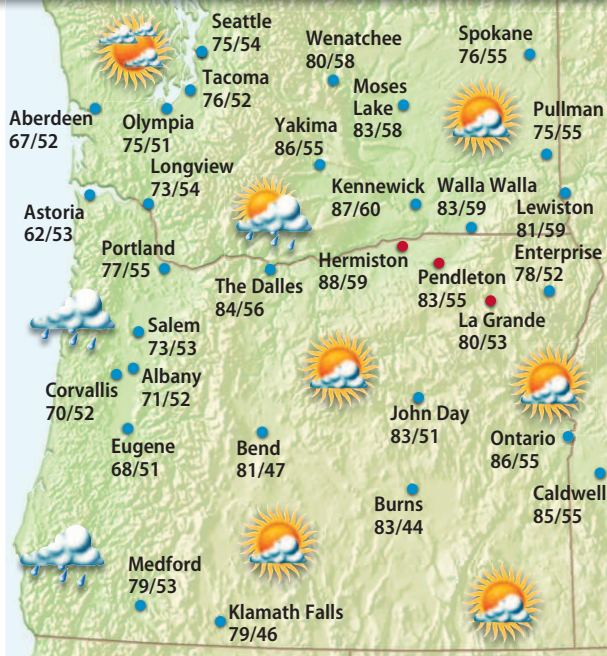

PENDLETON through 3 p.m. yesterday TEMPERATURE HIGH LOW. Includes precipitation and sun and moon data.



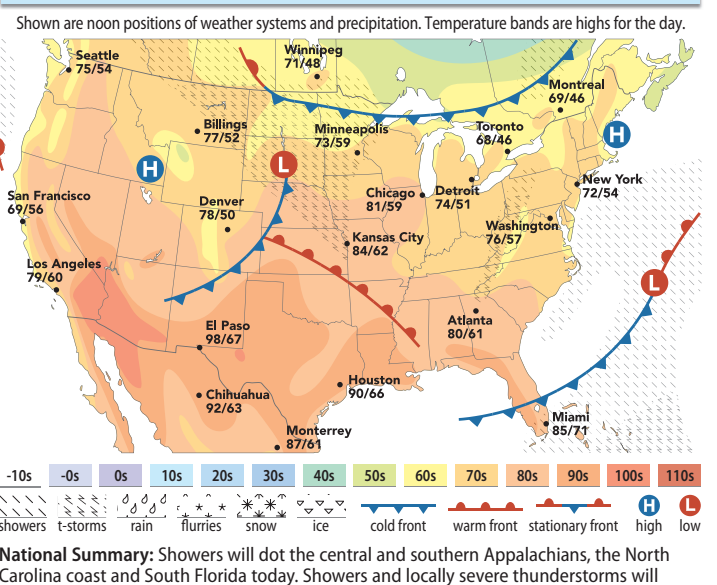

GOP gubernatorial candidates on abortion, taxes, PERS

By PARIS ACHEN Capital Bureau SALEM — Oregon Republicans have three distinct choices for their gubernatorial nominee on May 15.



Knute Buehler, Sam Carpenter and Greg Wooldridge are the three frontrunners for the Republican nomination for Oregon governor.

Sam Carpenter: Yes. We have this requirement for "tax increases." Anything that takes more money from the people should fall into this same category.

Greg Wooldridge: The Constitution is clear that raising taxes required a supermajority vote, and Democrats have circumvented this by claiming bills don't raise taxes, when, in fact, they do.

Knute Buehler: I believe climate change is real, and human activity is part of the problem. As governor, I'll drive us toward a balanced approach that transitions us to renewable sources without excessive, heavy-handed regulation that rewards cronyism, costs small businesses jobs and drives up the cost of living for hardworking Oregonians.
