SPOTLIGHT: Akers of EOU gets her first All-American honors

— Ellie Logan (Fossil), Northwest Nazarene track and field — After headlining last week's college spotlight, Logan continued to make waves after claiming a third-place finish in the women's javelin throw at the NCAA Division II national championships on May 26. She threw for 155 feet, 1 inch on her second attempt which at the time was good for second place. A fellow competitor from Angelo State knocked Logan into third but the Condon-Wheeler glad couldn't have been happier with how her season ended.

"It is not something I was ever expecting," Logan told NNUSports.com. "The overwhelming emotion is gratitude to be back throwing. To make it back to nationals and to be successful are not things I ever expected to happen.

"I'm just grateful for the moment and trying to enjoy it while I'm here."

The junior earned All-American honors with the podium finish, and will return to the Nighthawks basketball and track and field teams next year for her final seasons.

• Makayla Akers (Pendleton), Eastern Oregon track and field

— The Pendleton native and Hermiston High School grad had one of the best outings during the NAIA championships on May 24. As a member of Eastern Oregon University's track and field team, Akers highlighted the first day of nationals with a top finish in the women's javelin throw. Her mark of 41.93 meters put her on the podium in sixth place and gave the freshman her first All-American honors.

It was the Mountaineers first trip to the national stage, traveling nearly across the country to Gulf Shores, Alabama, but she was joined by a familiar face, which is the final athlete to round out this season's college spotlight.

• Ebony Wilson (Hermiston), Eastern Oregon track and field — Fellow Bulldog alumna also made the trip to compete in the women's long jump and in the 4x100-meter relay for EOU.

The freshman capped off her season with a 27th place finish in the long jump after reaching 5.12 meters on her second jump. Wilson then turned around to take the track as one of four Mountaineers on the 4x100 relay team. The group finished in 25th place after clocking 48.91 seconds.

in the state. ... They're going to be well-coached, they're going to be a great team, it's going to be a good game and I think the two right teams are playing each other here at the end."

Mayer will surely give the Buckaroos' talented hitters a challenge in the game. In three playoff wins over No. 11 Central, No. 14 Crater and No. 15 Lebanon, Mayer as allowed only six hits and four runs over 21 innings, while striking out 26 and walking only two. On top of that, she's a left-handed thrower — something the Buckaroos have only seen one time this season in Mac-

Hi's Sydney Earls.

"That's an extra element because you don't see very many lefties," Cary said. "That will be a little tricky and take a little time to adjust to."

However, the Buckaroos aren't too worried. They come in bearing one of the most prolific run-scoring teams in the state averaging more than 10 runs per game, and are fresh off a thrilling 20-10 win over defending state champs, Marist Catholic, in the semifinals. Pendleton has had the benefit of getting offensive contributions from nearly every single spot in the lineup this postseason.

Kirah McGlothan, the

team's leadoff hitter, has reached base nine times in 15 plate appearances and has scored eight runs. In the second spot, Lauren Richards has a team-best seven hits in 10 at-bats with six RBI. Rylee Gentner, the No. 6 hitter, has a team-high 10 RBI with two home runs and seven runs scored. Carissa Cooley, splitting time between the No. 8 and No. 9 spot, has three hits with five runs scored. Finally, the 3-4-5 hitters of Kahan McGlothan, Alexi Brehaut and Aspen Garton have a combined 10 hits with two home runs, three doubles, 12 RBI and 10 runs scored.

"We feel good as a group and I think we're in the right

place of where we want to be at the end of the season," Cary said. "I think the bats are where we want them to be, Lauren (Richards) is feeling good and healthy in the circle right now. I think the attitudes and energy is high right now, we're just itching to step on that diamond and get this thing going."

Before the Buckaroos play for a title, Pendleton's four seniors — Brehaut, Gentner, McGlothan, and Richards — will have a short graduation ceremony on the field. Pendleton High's graduation ceremony is Saturday morning at the Round-Up Stadium in town, though McGlothan said the seniors

aren't too sad about missing out.

"We would way rather graduate on the field than be out in the hot weather," McGlothan joked. "This is really special for us and we're excited."

It's not the first time this has happened to the Buckaroos in Cary's tenure, and he believes it's a much cooler experience than the traditional ceremony.

"It's a pretty cool deal, because 10 years from now, 15 years from now they can tell people 'I graduated on home plate at Oregon State on the softball diamond at the state championship,'" Cary said, "and that's something not many people can

say. I would think the rest of the graduates would be jealous of that."

Those four seniors witnessed the state championship stage from the dugout as freshmen and now hope to be the ones leading the team to its third state title.

"I do know we're going to miss them dearly next year," Cary said of the seniors. "But we're going to take advantage of having them for one more game, and I think they're going to end their careers the right way, go out and have the best game of their careers on Saturday."

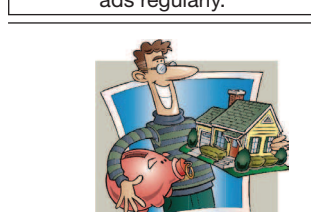
