

No. 5 Washington passes No. 1 Oregon in WCWS

OKLAHOMA CITY — On back-to-back days, Washington freshman Gabbie Plain stared down the toughest of challenges with seemingly no fear.

The Australian gave up four hits and no earned runs in six innings as Washington defeated top-seeded Oregon 6-2 on Friday in the Women's College World Series.

A day earlier, she gave up just four hits in 5 2/3 shut-out innings against two-time defending champion Oklahoma. She was the winning pitcher against the Sooners' Paige Parker and Oregon's Megan Kleist, both first-team National Fast-pitch Coaches Association All-Americans.

Plain said she's keeping it simple and trusting her defense.

"Good pitches, good locations, making them swing at stuff that they didn't necessarily want to swing at," she

said. "Yeah, just keeping on top of it."

Now, fifth-seeded Washington (51-8) needs one win Sunday to advance to the championship series.

Washington junior Taran Alvelo was solid in relief both games. Washington coach Heather Tarr said the Huskies know to play behind the very different personalities.

"Gabbie has that kind of chill, no worries personality," Tarr said. "Then you've got Taran that is a pump-you-up, fire-you-up kind of person. So you have to learn to play behind both personnel, and they have to learn to continue to regulate their hearts and be where they need to be when they need to be there."

Oregon (53-9) won all three meetings against its Pac-12 rival during the regular season. The Ducks said things were different Friday because they didn't play their best.

"I think they played

exactly the same way," Oregon third baseman Jenna Lilley said. "That's what made them good, except when we played them there, we made the defensive plays or we stopped the bleeding and we hit their pitchers around, and

today, we didn't."

The game was scoreless before Washington loaded the bases with one out in the fifth. Kelly Burdick put the ball in play and forced a throw home. Washington's Kaija Gibson scored,

despite taking a glove to the face on the tag attempt. Taylor Van Zee then singled and knocked in two runs to chase starter Megan Kleist. Washington scored four runs in the inning to take control for good.

"Just make adjustments," Van Zee said. "Obviously, it was our fourth game against them this year. So staying within ourselves, getting together, getting a pitch we could handle, just adjustments in the box and talking, communication amongst hitters. So it worked out for us."

Oregon will play an elimination game Saturday against the winner of the Georgia-Florida State game.

"We'll bounce back," Oregon coach Mike White said. "We know what we have to do. We just didn't execute. We didn't do what we needed to do to beat them today. They're a tough team. They were ranked number one in the country for a long time for a reason. They have a good pitching staff, superb defense, and a good mix of power and speed, and they put the pressure on you. But unfortunately we weren't able to make the big play."

No. 3 Oregon State downs Northwestern St.

CORVALLIS — Nick Madrigal went 3-for-5 with four RBIs and national No. 3 seed Oregon State defeated Northwestern State 9-3 on Friday night at the NCAA Corvallis Regional.

The Beavers (45-10-1) advance to face LSU on Saturday in the double-elimination regional.

Oregon State started Bryce Fehmel (10-1) rather than Pac-12 pitcher of the year Luke Heimlich. Head coach Pat Casey did not announce beforehand who he was going with.

Fehmel started strong with five strikeouts in the first three innings, matching his season-high. He went 7 2/3 innings, allowing three

runs on six hits with nine strikeouts for the win.

Madrigal hit a two-out bases-loaded single in the

third to give the Beavers a 2-0 lead and Kyle Nobach hit a two-run home run to center to extend the lead in

the fourth.

Lenni Kunert hit a solo shot to left center for the Demons in the fifth.

After Jack Anderson's RBI single padded Oregon State's lead in the sixth, Cadyn Grenier was hit by a pitch to score a run and Madrigal added a two-run double to put the Beavers up 8-1.

Kunert hit an RBI double in the seventh while Sam Taylor homered in the eighth to cut the margin to 8-3. Zak Taylor homered for the Beavers in the bottom half.

Left-hander Ridge Heisler (7-3) allowed eight runs, six earned, on six hits over 5 2/3 innings for Northwestern State (37-23), which returned to the postseason for the first time since 2005.

Timbers hoping win-streak continues

PORTLAND — Back on April 8 it seemed nothing was going right for the Portland Timbers.

In his debut season as an MLS coach, Giovanni Savarese's first five matches — all on the road — didn't include a single victory. He was clearly anxious to get back home after a 3-2 loss at Orlando City.

Portland had collected just two overall points in their first five games. The long road trip to start the season was caused by construction at Providence Park.

But once the Timbers got home, their season turned around quickly. Even dramatically. Since that loss in Florida, they've won six straight, capped by a 3-2 victory at Colorado last weekend. On Saturday, they'll host the LA Galaxy.

The six consecutive wins is a club record, and matches Orlando's streak for the longest this season. It also matches the second-longest winning streak in the league since 2000 — when MLS started recording draws. Sporting Kansas City won seven straight in 2012.

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
