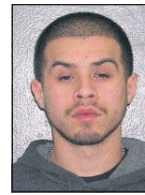


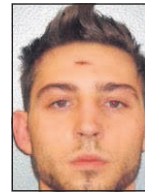

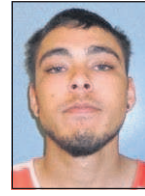

Arrests made in homicide outside Oregon supermarket

PORTLAND — Police arrested an Oregon man accused of fatally shooting a friend in retaliation for a gun deal in which he was robbed.

Rees Dikeos, 20, of Lake Oswego was arrested in Las Vegas this week, according to the Newberg-Dundee

Police Department. He was later booked into the Yamhill County Jail on a murder charge.

A second suspect, Mark Gonzalez, 27, of Beaverton has been charged with conspiracy to commit murder.

The victim, 20-year-old Jack Burnell, was killed Jan. 12 in an alley near a Newberg supermarket.
