STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING
The 2018-2019 budget is created utilizing an \$8.2 billion state budget. 50% is budgeted in the second year of the biennium. The District is experiencing decreased enrollment, resulting in decreased state funding. There are two retiring positions not being replaced. District is maintaining all current programs and honoring the negotiated agreement, including a COLA and steps.
