Chester William "Bill" Dyer died Friday, July 20, 2018, at Oregon Veterans Home in The Dalles. He was 80 years old.

Bill was born July 2, 1938, at The Dalles. He was one of three children born to Chester R. "Buzz" and Roberta Crawford Dyer. He attended grade school at Mayville, and graduated from Condon High School in 1956. After attending college, he served in the United States Army during the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1963. He served in the Reserves until 1967. In 1966, Bill was married to Karen Barker in Condon. The couple had two children, Howard and Amy. In 1987, he married Sally Palmer Green in Arlington. Bill was the third generation to farm his family's Century Farm, originally homesteaded by his grandfather, J.W. Dyer. The farm is currently in the hands of his son, Howard. Bill enjoyed spending time with his family and many friends. He was an avid sportsman and loved hunting, fishing, bowling and golf. He was an active member of the Kinzua Hills Golf Club, Condon Golf Club, and the Senior Blues golf organization. He enjoyed coaching Little League and Babe Ruth baseball for a number of years. He took great pleasure watching his kids play sports.

A member of various organizations, Bill belonged to the Condon Grain Growers and the United Church of Christ. He was a 60-year member of the Condon Elks Lodge, and also served on the local Selective Service board. Bill was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by Sally, his wife of 31 years; children Howard Dyer and Amy Wenzloff; stepchildren Janice Blouse and Bryan Green; grandchildren Wendell Smith, Ava and Paris Green, Melissa Sutton, Jenna Santos; and two great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his sisters, Jo Ann Dyer Turner of Federal Way, Washington, and Mary Dyer of Condon.

A graveside memorial service with military honors will be held Monday, Aug. 6 at 11 a.m. at the Mayville Cemetery. A potluck meal and celebration of Bill's life will follow at the United Church of Christ Fellowship Hall in Condon.
