**Conditional Use Permit CUP-S-311A -18: John Flynn, applicant and owner.** The property is described as tax lots 2400 and 2402 of Assessor's Map 3S 25 and tax lot 400 of Assessor's Map 4S 25. The property is zoned Exclusive Farm Use (EFU) and located just south of the Ruggs junction on Highway 207. Request is to allow by conditional use a guest ranch.
